The Senate Appropriations Committee

The Senate Appropriations Committee is the largest committee in the Senate, with 31 members. One of the most powerful and prestigious committees, it is responsible for determining the spending levels for each government program. Each subcommittee drafts an appropriations bill for its jurisdiction; those 12 bills then combine to form the chamber's full appropriations package. The committee also reviews all proposed amendments to the final bill, avoiding spontaneous floor amendments. Its office is in S-128 of the Capitol, with subcommittee offices in the Dirksen Senate Office Building.
