THE FEDERAL BUDGET PROCESS

Federal agencies begin developing their budgets 18 months ahead of the next fiscal year. The executive branch formalizes their budget proposal in February and sends it to Congress for 8 months of reports, hearings, and votes. The below timeline outlines what that process looks like from start to finish.
